

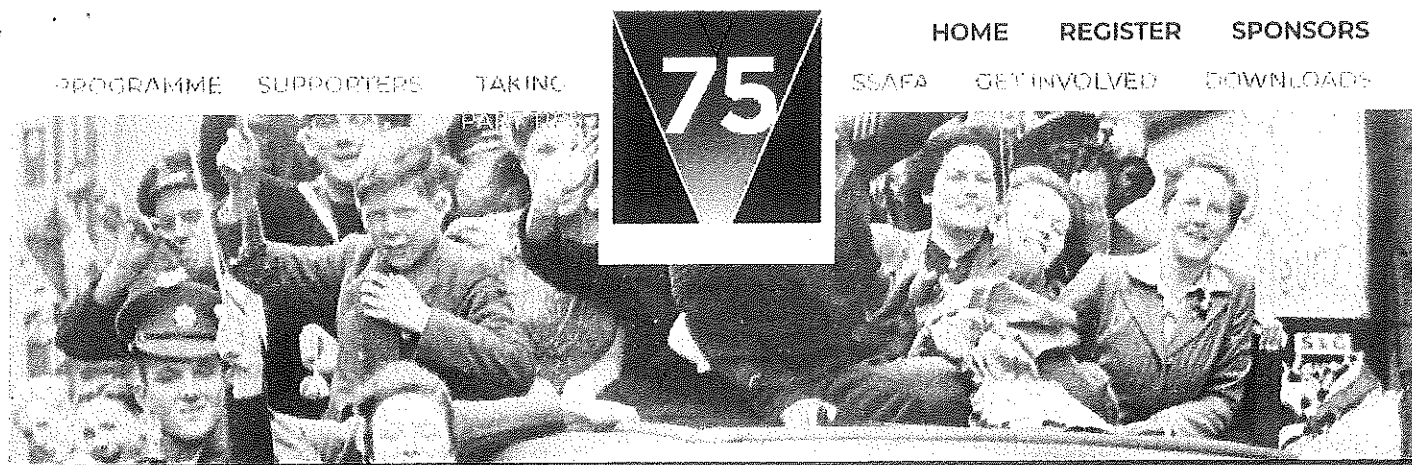

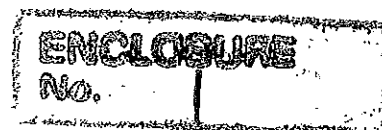
BE PART OF THE BUILD-UP

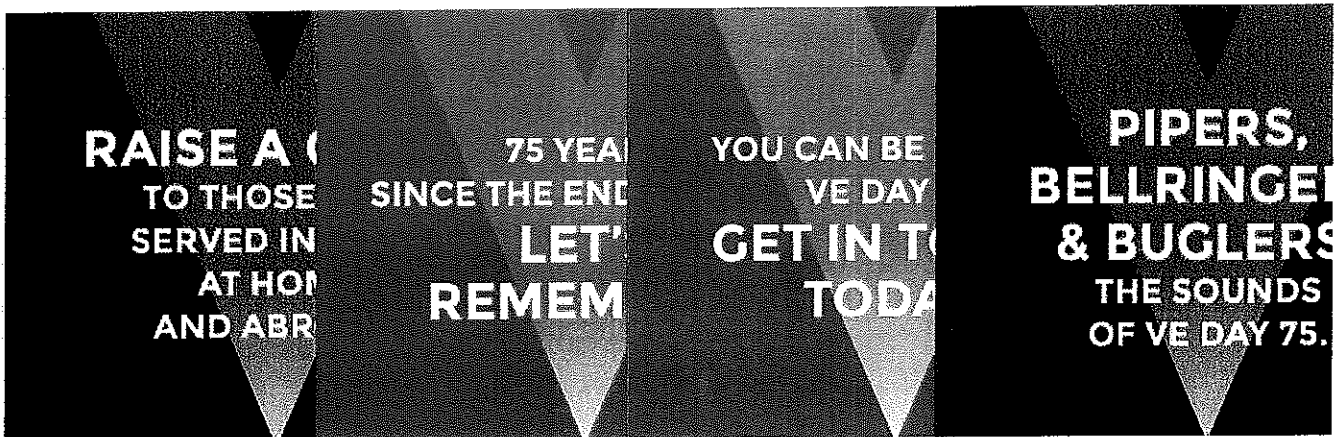

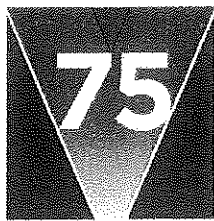
